American Councils for International Education has completed all testing for the for the FLEX Secondary School Exchange Program 2018-2019 program cycle in Turkmenistan.

More than 400 students in Turkmenistan participated from seven different testing center of the country. Final results for all regions expected in April of 2018.

Finalists in the competition will have the opportunity to live with an American family and study in an American high school during the 2018-2019 school year.

The FLEX program pays for all travel, housing and living expenses for program participants with all funding generously provided by the Government of the United States of America. FLEX testing is open to all high school students who meet the requirements of the program including students with disabilities. More than 300 disabled students have participated in FLEX over the program's history, including 6 from Turkmenistan.

The next FLEX testing cycle for the 2019-2020 school year will likely begin in September of 2018. Students, teachers, and parents should check our website, call our office, or visit their nearest American Corner in August of 2018 for details on testing dates, student eligibility requirements, and special testing opportunities for students with disabilities.
