Eligibility/Requirements for Potential Candidates:

- 2) No Bachelor's degree yet;
- 3) Not enrolled in a university either in Turkmenistan or another country (students of professional schools may apply);
- 4) Intermediate/Advanced level of English;
- 5) Motivated toward academic success and study at U.S. colleges and universities;
- 6) Ready for challenges!

- A completed U.S. Common Application in PDF format (the form is attached);
- U.S. Common Application essay;
- A completed Prep4Success Program Application (the form is attached);
- Statement of Purpose;
- Your secondary school academic transcripts;
- Two (2) signed academic recommendation letters in English;
- CV or Resume;
- A copy of passport;
- Recent passport size photo;
- Official TOEFL and/or SAT scores if you have taken them
(Official TOEFL or SAT scores are **NOT** required for admission into this course)
