Finalists in the competition will have the opportunity to live with an American family and study in an American high school during 2017-2018 school year. The program pays for all travel, housing and living expenses for program participants.

The number of FLEX finalists from Turkmenistan has been increased to 25 this year!

We invite all students to participate in the fall 2016 competition who:

- were born in the period between **March 15, 1999** to **May 31, 2001**;
- have not lived in the United States for more than three months in the last five years;
- are studying in a high school, have good or excellent grades, and have a good command of English;
- meet the requirements to get US Visa;
- eligible to get Turkmenistan international passport.

In order to participate in competition please:

- **bring a proof of eligibility (original birth certificate or passport),**
- **one recent photograph (3x4 cm),**
- **a pen,**
- **and be wearing your school uniform.**

Students with disabilities are also encouraged to participate in the competition.
