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How to Use an Education Fair

The U.S. Education Fair will provide you with innumerable opportunities to connect with representatives from U.S. colleges and universities that are actively seeking students just like you. For many of you who cannot visit the colleges you are interested in, this is your chance to learn first-hand about the particular schools, and for the representatives to meet and learn a bit about you!

Please register on the fair platform by following the link <https://acfacts.easyvirtualfair.com/>. Include your name, email address, country and desired level of study. We advise you to use a computer when you first register on the website, while for future logins you may use your mobile devices, so you can attend online sessions, ask questions, and chat at any location. On the platform you may add information to share with representatives of U.S. colleges and universities, such as a resume or CV, preferred field of study, contact details for future interactions with American higher education institutions.

Take a few minutes to review the school profiles. We hope that you have had an opportunity to do some advance research about the schools participating in the fair today. The college and universities profiles on the fair webpage will help you learn about participating institutions so that you can use your time efficiently.

Formulate questions that will give you information that is useful in your search. This can be done before even visiting online fair, but as you become engaged in this process, you will think of many more questions.

Don't be afraid. Approach representatives and ask questions. If you feel embarrassed at first, observe others. The representatives who are at the fair are skilled in helping students get started.

Keep an open mind. With over four thousand colleges and universities in the U.S., it is impossible to know about all of them. The education fair gives you an opportunity to learn something new about a school you would have never considered.

After the Fair. After the fair, talk with your parents about what you learned, perhaps even make some notes in a journal while your thoughts are fresh. If you were especially impressed with a college, you may want to follow up with the representative. You may contact that person via email, telephone or regular mail.

Sample Questions to Ask College Representatives

- What is the ratio of students to faculty?
- How accessible are professors outside of class?
- How active is your international student affairs office and what programs do they offer throughout the year?
- What do students like most about college? Like least?
- What are the dominant social groups on campus?
- What are the most popular/famous programs on campus?
- What might students do on a typical weekend?
- What housing opportunities are available (on-campus dormitories, apartments, co-ops, off-campus housing)?
- What is the graduation rate? What is the graduation rate for international students?
- What kind of career services are available for international students?
- Do you offer deferred admissions?
- Can international students work on campus?

What is A U.S. Community College Student?

A community college student is someone seeking a professional certificate or an associate degree. An associate degree usually takes two years to complete and can be a stepping stone to earning a bachelor's degree at a four-year college or university.

Credit and degrees often transfer from community colleges to four-year colleges or universities. In this "2+2 process," you earn a bachelor's degree with two years of community college, followed by two years of university study.

Admissions requirements are more flexible at community colleges than at four-year institutions, and many have rolling deadlines for admissions. Tuition and fees are lower, and most community colleges do not require standardized admissions tests (only a test of English for international students). Each community college will specify required admissions requirements on the school website.

U.S. community college students often work while pursuing their studies. Community colleges offer flexible course schedules to accommodate students' lives outside of school; students can usually take courses during the day or in the evening, part-time or full-time.

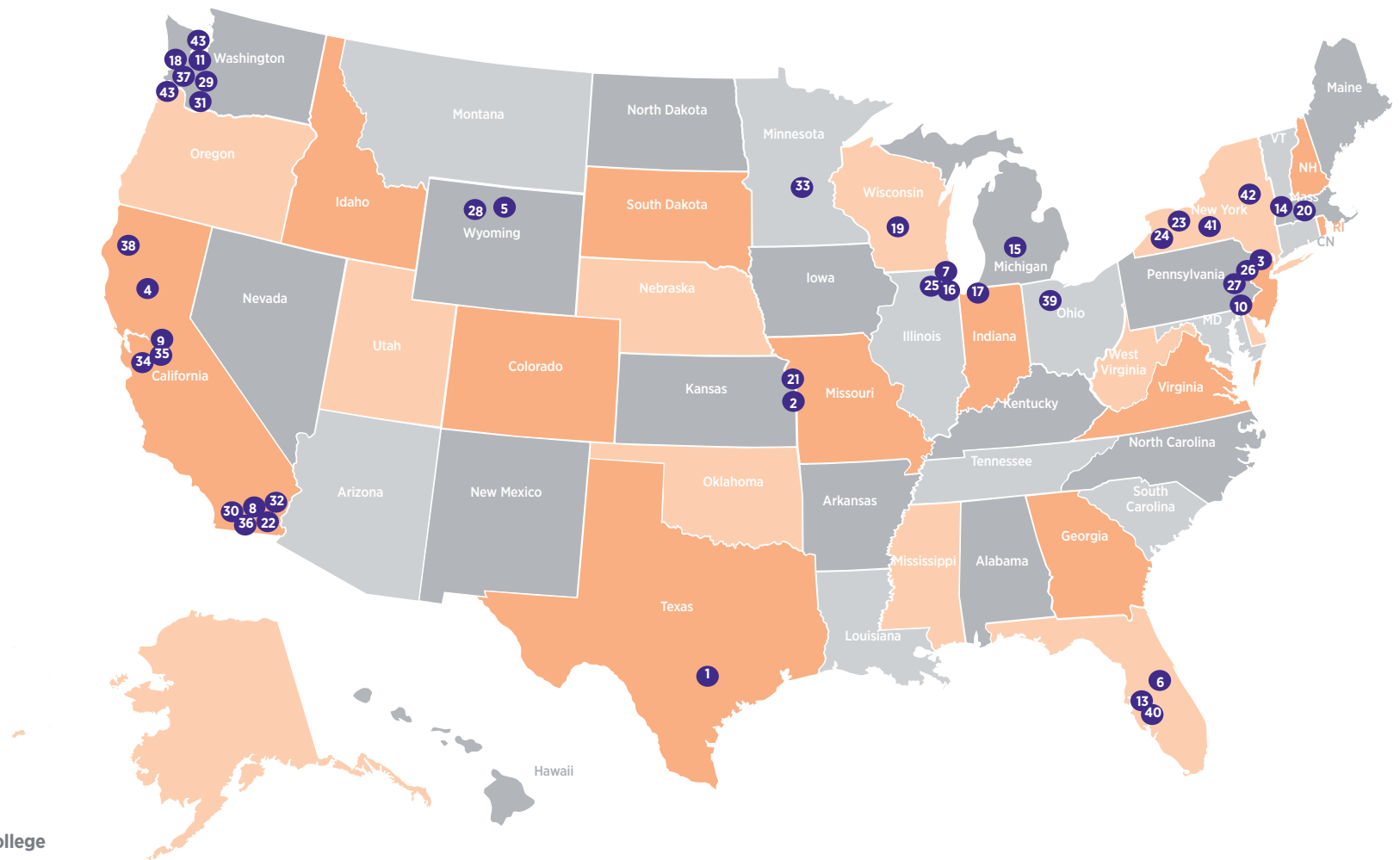
Programs especially popular among international students include business, computer science, computer graphics, internet technology, multimedia, hotel management, restaurant management, psychology, accounting, early childhood education, and environmental conservation.

Students can lower the overall cost of a bachelor's degree by taking the first two years of study at a community college. Students should design their programs of study with a college counselor and pay close attention to agreements among institutions to make sure the credits for courses completed at the community college transfer to a four-year university program.
